

## Padanaram

August 1-2

Rex has been working to get us set up at Padanaram. Corinthian YC will be there at the same time as our visit, which is going to make it a little more challenging to book moorings in advance. Most of the transient moorings are booked through the NBYC, and they are saying that they have all been taken by Corinthian. Rex spoke with Geoff Marshall (long time member of NBYC) who said that availability really depends on what members are away that weekend (freeing up moorings) and that as we get closer more moorings will free up. For dockage, South Wharf has slips, and registration is open NOW on Dockwa. The Town of Dartmouth also has 4-6 moorings available just inside the causeway. Rex has been in touch with the Harbormaster about these, and they are on a first come, first served basis so can NOT be reserved in advance. Rex is going to try to get a few of the catboaters (the Padanaram Catboat Rendezvous is that weekend, but they will all be up the cove at Marshall) to use them, then pass them along to us. Anchoring is always an option s well!



Anchorage is also available with good holding in Lagoon pond if anyone wants to anchor. Lagoon Pond is beyond the drawbridge and has an air clearance of 12'. Bridge opens on a schedule

## Osterville

August 5-6

Here is some info for Osterville. From looking at cruising guides it looks like the controlling depth for the channel is 8'. Sarah Browne spoke with the dock master at Oyster Harbors Marine (see below) and he recommends a max draft for the mooring field and anchorage in North Bay of 6'-not sure if that will be an issue for anyone. To Note: Our friends at Corinthian YC seem to have a similar plan to ours, and will be in Osterville that week (as they will be in Padanaram when we are there), but it is not confirmed as of yet if we overlap with them. I would recommend booking ASAP!!

From Sarah Browne: *I also talked to the dock master at Oyster Harbors Marina and he has 4-5 moorings available for transients and we can reserve them. Not likely to have slips available but he would try to accommodate if someone really wanted a slip. Moorings are \$40 /night. Crosby Yacht yard has moorings and slips for transients. Dock Master at Oyster Harbors told me most people go into North Bay and anchor - very comfortable and good holding.*
