NOTICE OF RACE 2020 DUTCH ISLAND" PURSUIT RACE September 19, 2020

1. Organizing Authority

The Wickford Yacht Club pursuit race is sponsored by the Wickford Yacht Club (WYC). The Wickford Yacht Club is the race organizing authority. This race is open to WYC members and guests.

2. Rules

- 2.1 The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017 – 2020, except as modified by this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any Amendments to the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2 All yachts must have the safety equipment on board as required by the US Coast Guard and the State of Rhode Island.
- 2.3 US Sailing Rule 82 is waived for this event.

3. Eligibility

Each yacht sailing must submit their latest PHRF. If you do not have one, one will be assigned to you. Failure to either submit or request to have one assigned will result in the yacht being scored DNC. Rating changes will not be made retroactive to the Race.

PHRFs may be left in the Rear Commodore's mailbox, sent via email (nbergh@msn.com), or indicate that we already have it if you are a Wednesday Night racer.

3.1 Classes: All Yachts will race in Cruising Class. PHRF Certificates may be obtained by applying to:

4. Owner and Person in Charge

4.1 The term "Person in Charge" means the person who is designated in the Entry Form who will act as Captain of the yacht during the series.

5. Responsibilities of Competitors

As a condition precedent to his or her participation in the Dutch Island Pursuit Race (including without limitation all activities relating to events sponsored by the Wickford Yacht Club), each participant assumes any and all risks associated with such participation and each yacht and each participant waives and releases any and all claims, including those of negligence or equivalent

conduct against the host, its directors, members, employees, representatives, and associated volunteers.

6. Race Procedures

The race chair must receive a registration from each Owner or Person in charge of each participating yacht by 6 PM September 17, 2019. All Notices are available at:

7. Sailing Instructions

The 2020 Pursuit Race Sailing Instructions will be available September 02, 2019 online at www.wickfordyc.com. BE SURE TO BRING THEM WITH YOU WHEN RACING.

8. Course

The race will be held in the vicinity of Wickford Harbor and Dutch Island in Narragansett Bay. There will be a long course A for medium to heavy wind and a short course B for light wind. The courses will be posted on www.wickfordyc.com under the racing tab. Both Courses will be using Government US Government Navigation Aids which appear on all Narragansett Bay Charts. The actual course to be sailed by all boats will be determined at the Captain's meeting at the WYC at 0930 on Saturday 9/19.

9. Awards

Awards will be awarded for the first, second and third place finishers.

10. Dispute Resolution

The Procedures outlined in the RRS 2017-2020 shall apply except as modified by this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any Amendments to the Sailing Instructions.

11. Radio Communications

All Boats will attempt to monitor Channel 78 throughout the racing series. Except in an emergency, boats shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12. Social Activities and Facilities

12.1 Due to COVID-19 restrictions there will be no post-race gathering of participants.

12.2 Dock usage at the Yacht Club is for loading and unloading only. The main loading dock is reserved for the specific use of the Race Committee.

12.3 Parking at the Wickford Yacht Club is limited, and the parking lot is reserved for club members only. Please car-pool if possible. The East Side of Pleasant Street near the Yacht Club is a NO PARKING ZONE to establish a fire lane. The end of Pleasant Street is a public boat ramp, DO NOT PARK IN THE LOADING RAMP AREA. The Town will ticket and tow violators. If members park in the Yacht Club parking lot, leave your keys in the car so as not to block others. Many children, walkers and bikers use Pleasant Street so please travel slowly, let's be good neighbors!

12.4 Competitors, crew, and their guests will comply with the rules of the Wickford Yacht Club while on the premises. Any damage or theft may result in an assessment of the registrants.

13. Changes to the Notice of Race

The Wickford Yacht Club reserves the right to amend this Notice of Race. Any such changes will be made prior to the Saturday, September 19th race and will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board at Wickford Yacht Club.
